Randy Perkins (D)

Randy Perkins is the owner and CEO of AshBritt. In 1992, Hurricane Andrew hit South Florida with Category 5 winds, uprooting lives, leaving many families displaced, and causing catastrophic damage. He is president of the Board of Trustees of Temple Judea in Palm Beach Gardens and is active in the ARC of Palm Beach County and the Jewish Federation of Palm Beach County. He also volunteers his time providing pro bono representation to children and young adults who are aging out of the Palm Beach County foster care program and Holocaust ghetto survivors obtaining reparations from the German government. Jonathan and his wife, Christina, live in North Palm Beach with their three children
